**Tickets:** Tickets will be available at the Spectator Entrance near the football field and outside the gym entrance upstairs for \$10.00 each. Programs will be available for \$2.00 at the ticket table. As each ensemble arrives, all members of participating ensembles will have their hands stamped. The staff, equipment crew, and chaperones will need to show their current NYSPC passes for entrance. Cash and Venmo will be accepted.

**Pre-performance Announcements:** All announcements should be completed via the survey provided. We will supply extra forms of the NYSPC Announcer Template if needed.

**Registration:** A representative from each ensemble will need to register their group at the performer drop off entrance. Each ensemble will receive:

- Final performance, warm-up, and report/staging times
- Homeroom and warm-up area assignments
- Room contracts
- School and gymnasium maps

**Classrooms:** Each group will have two classrooms for storage of equipment. Large timpani and marimbas will not fit into the classrooms.

**Warm-up areas:** There are 3 designated warm-up areas. Each ensemble will have 30 minutes of warm-up time.

1. Junior High Cafeteria
2. Junior High Gym
3. Auditorium

**Concessions:** A variety of hot and cold items will be for sale in the cafeteria, such as chicken fingers, mac & cheese, nachos & cheese, pizza, chips, cookies, soda, gatorade, and water. A full menu will be listed in the program and outside of the cafeteria. Candy grams will be available to purchase outside the gym. Cash and Venmo accepted. The concession area will open at 11:30am for ensembles arriving early and will remain open throughout the show. **Please contact Kirstie Sheets ([kirstiesheets@gmail.com](mailto:kirstiesheets@gmail.com)) if your ensemble plans to eat before the show so that we can prepare for them).** We ask that all food and drink remain outside of the gymnasium and warm-up areas.

**Buses & Trucks** are to follow the signs to their designated drop-off, loading, and parking areas. There are 4 designated areas for equipment trucks to unload. The main unloading area is at the Cobblestone entrance. There will be two lanes set up - one for bus drop offs and one for equipment truck unloading. There is also an equipment truck unloading area at the end of the hallway of the assigned classrooms for each ensemble, but **space is limited in these lots**. There will be volunteers outside directing buses and equipment trucks to their designated drop off, unloading, and parking spots.

**Prop/Equipment Storage:** All equipment must enter the gym before performing and is to be removed from the gym after your performance. There is a storage area in the auxiliary gym adjacent to the performance floor that can be utilized before the show begins. After the show begins there will be additional prop storage available in the hallway to the left of the performer entrance of the gym.

**Timing Line:** There is a vertical timing line. Ensembles will enter from the backside door to the gym, to the audience's right. They will exit through the backside doors, to the audience's left. The maximum performance area is 90' x 60' with 5' of space in front and back. Please see attached map.

**Critique:** Critique will take place in the Library/Media Center, Room 123, fifteen minutes following the last performance. The instructional staff for each competing ensemble will have 4 minutes to speak with each judge following the awards ceremony.

**Senior Recognition:** We will recognize one senior prior to retreat.

**Retreat:** There will be a "captains only" retreat following the performances. Captains should report to the gym entrance when the last performance begins.
