The staff and equipment crew will need to show their current NYSPC passes for entrance. Additional parents and chaperones will need to pay for admission to the contest. Cash and card accepted

**Pre-performance Announcements:** All announcements should be turned in at or prior to check-in. We will supply extra forms of the NYSPC Announcer Template if needed.

**Registration:** A representative from each ensemble will need to register their group at the student/equipment drop off entrance. Each ensemble will receive:

- Final Performance, Warm-Up, and Report/Staging Times
- Homeroom and Warm-up Area Assignments
- Room Contracts
- School and Gymnasium Maps

**Homerooms:** Each group will have 2 classrooms for storage of equipment. Large timpani and marimbas will not fit into the classrooms.

**Warm-up areas:** There are 2 warm-up areas: Cafeteria (A) and Auditorium (B). Each performing ensemble will have 18 minutes of warm-up time in a large room. PLEASE NOTE: Your entrance is the corresponding warmup area, so if in warmup A, you get dropped off at entrance A.

**Concessions:** A variety of hot and cold items will be for sale in the concession stand by the gym. The concession area will open at 4pm and will remain open throughout the show.

**Buses & Trucks** are to follow the signs to their designed drop-off, loading, and parking areas. There will be plenty of volunteers ready to assist you.

**Equipment:** All equipment must enter the gym before you perform and is to be removed from the gym

after your performance. There will be a concert bass drum, chimes and 4 timpani available upon request. Please contact Joe Stork, Band Director, jstork@cppasd.com, 585-737-2999 if you need to borrow any equipment.

**Equipment/Prop Storage:** Props and large equipment can be stored in the AUX gym.

**Timing Line:** There is a vertical timing line. Ensembles will enter from the back of the gym, to the audience's left. They will exit through the rear doors, to the audience's right. See map.

**Post Contest Critique:** Critique will take place in the library, 15 minutes following the last performance. The Instructional Staff for each competing ensemble will have 4 minutes to speak with each judge following the awards ceremony.

**Retreat:** There will be a "captains only" retreat following the performances. Captains should report to the gym entrance when the last performance begins.

## **Transportation Specifics**

- All transportation should enter through the Aisne Street entrance. Any other entrance will not allow you to reach the student and equipment/prop drop off.
- All transportation should take a left after entering the campus. Busses and equipment trucks follow around to the back of the school.
- **Group Entrance B:** Have your buses and equipment pull as far forward and to the right as possible. All groups must unload immediately. After unloading, the buses and trucks should proceed to the Bus/Equipment Truck Parking. Store your pit equipment in the hallway outside of your room.
- **Group Entrance A:** Have your buses park in the Bus/Equipment Truck Parking, located near Group Entrance A. Have the equipment truck pull forward to the Group Entrance. All groups must unload immediately. Push your equipment down the A 100 hall.
- **Large Props:** If your ensemble has large props, please bring them to the Aux Gym upon arrival. Your group will be able to retrieve them while at staging.
- **After your Performance:** You will be instructed to load your equipment truck. While exiting please understand, groups entering warm ups/performance zones have the right of way. You will use an exit near entrance A to exit straight to the bus and equipment parking lot.
