Pre-performance Announcements: All announcements should be completed via the link provided earlier this season. We will supply extra forms of the NYSPC Announcer Template if needed.

Registration: A representative from each ensemble will need to register their group at the student/equipment drop off entrance. Each ensemble will receive:

- Final Performance, Warm-Up, and Report/Staging Times
- Homeroom and Warm-up Area Assignments
- Room Contracts
- School and Gymnasium Maps

Homerooms: Each group will have two classrooms for storage of equipment. Large timpani and marimbas will not fit into the classrooms. Please note, the first 3 performing groups can bring their equipment right into the warm-up areas if they choose to do so.

Warm-up areas: There are 3 warm-up areas: the auxiliary gym, cafeteria, and the auditorium. Each performing ensemble will have 30 minutes of warm-up time in a large room.

Concessions: Concessions will be open starting at 12:00 PM and will remain open throughout the show. A variety of foods will be available for purchase, with a full menu listed in the program and outside the dry cafeteria. We ask that all food and drink remain outside of the gym and warm-up areas.

Buses & Trucks: Please follow the signs to their designed drop-off, loading, and parking areas. There will be volunteers ready to assist you.

Equipment: All equipment must enter the gym before you perform and is to be removed from the gym after your performance. There will be a concert bass drum, chimes and 4 timpani available upon request. Please make arrangements with Elizabeth Otero at 315-378-6977. Please call in advance so arrangements can be made.

Equipment/Prop Storage: Props will be stored in the technology wing. (If entering from the main entrance, it's the last hallway on the right.) Areas will be labeled for each performing group.

Timing Line: Maximum performance area is 65' X 100'. Timeline is vertical. Entry from Rear Side 1, Exit Rear Side 2 (Left to Right from judge perspective. See map.)



Retreat: There will be a captain's only retreat following senior recognition.


